

Post-Operative Care Instructions for Closed Nasal Reduction

What to Expect & Do

Nasal Packing

- May have absorbable nasal packing and a small moustache dressing.
- Helps control bleeding and support bone fragments.
- Packing will dissolve or fall out on its own.

Nasal Congestion

- Nose will feel blocked/stuffy for about 1 week.
- Gradually improves over several weeks.
- Breathing should improve as swelling settles.

Nasal Splint/Cast

- Keep splint/cast on for at least 1 weeks.
- It may start loosening after 5–7 days.
- Reinforce with tape to keep it in place.

Nasal Irrigation/Spray

• If crusting or dryness occurs, use saline spray (chemist).

Post-Operative Visits

- Usually not required if recovery is smooth.
- We will set you up for a phone call in a month.
- Contact us if you have concerns.

Precautions - First Week

- Activity: Increase gradually. Sleep with head elevated (pillows or recliner). Use ice packs on nose/face (20 min on / 20 min off) for the first day.
- **Do Not Blow Nose**: Avoid nose-blowing for 1 week.
- **Sneezing**: Sneeze with mouth open to reduce pressure.
- Pain relief: Paracetamol and/or ibuprofen as needed.
